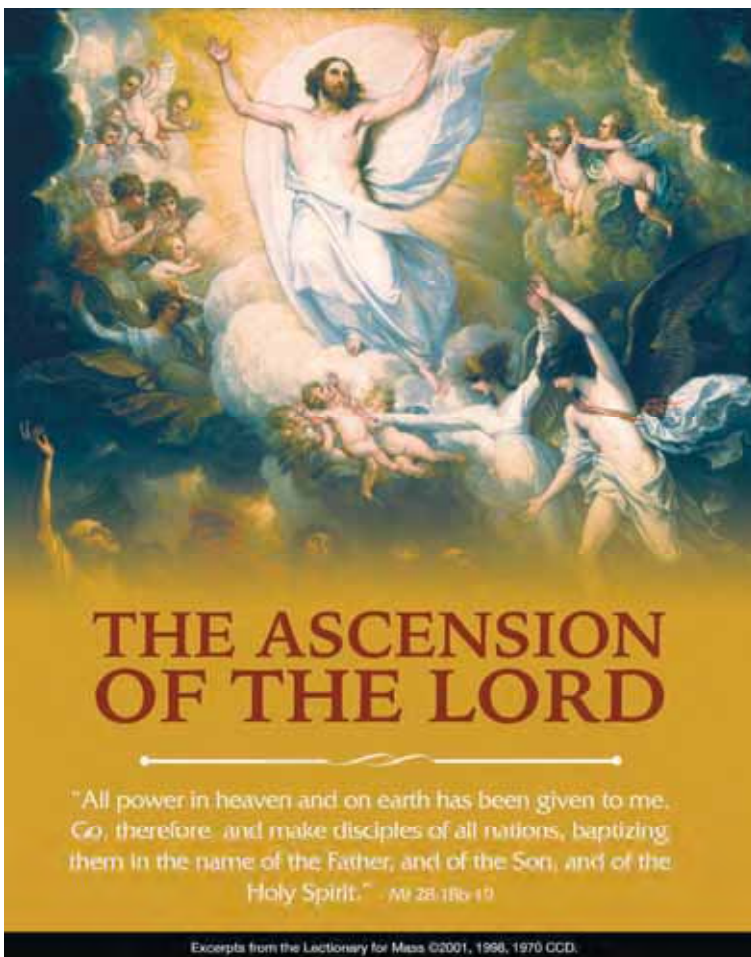

From the Deacon's Desk

This is the last weekend of the May. Monday, we celebrate Memorial Day, a day when we remember all those that have given their lives serving our country. We honor these people as heroes by visiting their gravesites or memorials, taking flowers, mementos and American flags. Our most important offering of course is prayers and Masses offered for their souls and for their families they have left behind. We thank Our Lord that there are so many people willing to make the ultimate sacrifice in order to guard our freedom of religion, speech, work, school, and so many freedoms which give us dignity and quality of life.

This weekend is also the first long weekend of the summer season which ends with the Labor Day weekend in September. Schools are out, vacation is in full swing for all students. Hopefully some of us will be able to take that very deserved rest and fly away to a secluded destination to enjoy family and refresh/renew our bodies, minds and souls!

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. According to the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops; this Solemnity, "The universal church celebrates the Ascension of the Lord the Thursday of the Sixth week of Easter. In many archdioceses and dioceses of the United States, the celebration of the Ascension of the Lord is transferred to the following Sunday, which is May 28th." In today's Gospel of Matthew Jesus instructs the Apostles to, "Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you." This is also an invitation to all of us to continue Christ's mission in the world. In the Acts of the Apostles at the Ascension we see the eleven disciples exhibiting "very human" behavior when we hear that, "They worshiped but doubted." In another verse, we see how they are looking at the sky as Jesus ascends when they are told, "Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky?" As if they were being reprimanded for standing around instead of getting busy and start working at carrying the mission of spreading the Good News throughout the world!

All of us as baptized Roman Catholics have been given the responsibility to be disciples and help with spreading the Good News in our respective communities, beginning with the Domestic Church which is our home. This responsibility is not left alone for priests, deacons, or religious leaders. All lay people including the ordained are members of the body the church, we all are the ones that make the universal church. All we need to do is look around on any given Eucharistic celebration and see how many people are involved to make this happen! One person can't do it all so as members of the Church it is our responsibility to teach and help others in their formation. Each one of us must do our job in evangelizing and catechizing all the people around us and those who we meet at work or at school. This does not necessarily need to be in a formal basis through classes, but informally as well. It does not mean that we go around "preaching to others all the time" but instead we are called to teach by our example and by the way we live our daily lives. Remember St. Francis tells us "evangelize and only when necessary use words". In order to be able to spread the good news we need to learn and study the Word of God, so please make an effort to join or form a Bible study group in your home. There are many Catholic guides for studying the Bible, as well as videos and numerous resources. You will see how much fruit will come from your effort! May the Risen Lord bless our efforts as we go on spreading His Good News!



Sacrament of Baptism

Worshiping with us at Mass is a time to spiritually prepare both you and your family for the Sacrament of Baptism.

Parents who are registered in the parish desiring and planning baptism for their child are to come by the office to register for baptism classes. Pre-baptism classes are required for both parents and Godparents. Godparents must have received the sacrament of Confirmation and, if married, married in the Roman Catholic Church and be receiving Holy Communion regularly. Only one Godparent is necessary. If two (2), then male and female are required. Please come by the office to register for baptism classes. Two consecutive classes are required. **The next classes are scheduled for Tuesdays, May 30 and June 6, 2017. Please call the office to register.**

THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Jesus came to heal the whole person, body and soul. In the Church's Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, through the ministry of the priest, it is Jesus who touches the sick to heal them from sin - and sometimes even from physical ailment. His cures were signs of the arrival of the Kingdom of God. The core message of his healing tells us of his plan to conquer sin and death by his dying and rising.

The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient.

When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be God's will, the person be physically healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age.

Each first Friday of the month, this Sacrament is offered during the 9:00 a.m. Mass at the Basilica of San Albino. If you are in need of the Anointing of the Sick, or know someone who is, you are invited to join us or bring those who would like to have the Anointing but cannot bring themselves, to Mass on Friday, June 2nd at 9:00 a.m.
