## SAINT JOAN OF ARC

(1412-1431)

Patron Saint of France and Military

Feast day - May 30

Joan was born of a fairly well-to-do peasant couple in Domremy-Greux (southeast of Paris). She was only 12 when she experienced a vision and heard voices that she later identified as St Michael the Archangel, St Catherine of Alexandria, and St Margaret of Antioch.

During the Hundred Years War, she led the French troops against the English and recaptured the cities of Orléans and Troyes. This enabled Charles VII to be crowned as king in Reims in 1429. Captured near Compiegne the following year, and when Charles and the French did nothing to save her, she was sold to the English and placed on trial for heresy and witchcraft. In the end, she was condemned for wearing men's clothes.

On May 30, 1431, she was burned at the stake in Rouen, and her ashes were scattered in the Seine River. She was nineteen years old. As she was being burned at the stake, Joan called on Jesus. A second Church trial 25 years later nullified the earlier verdict, which was reached under political pressure.

Remembered by most people with her earlier military exploits, Joan had a great love for the sacraments, which strengthened her compassion towards the poor. Theologian George Tavard writes that her life "offers perfect example of the conjunction of contemplation and action" because her spiritual insight is that there should be a "unity of heaven and earth."

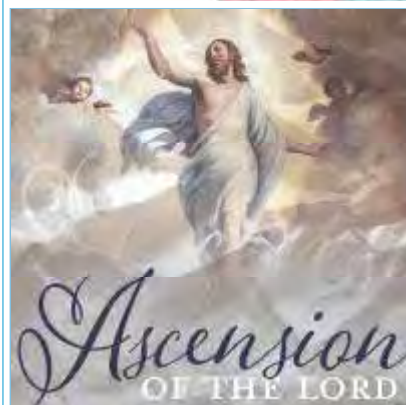


May is the month of our Blessed Mother. Join us as we pray the rosary on Mondays at 4:30 pm and Sundays at 10:30 am.

The Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary

**May 31, 2019**

**5:30 pm**

Procession around the plaza and Vespers followed by Italian Sodas in the parish hall.

Plenary indulgence available for those who meet the requirements.

A plenary indulgence can be gained only once a day. In order to obtain it, the faithful must, in addition to being in the state of grace, have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin and:

- 1\*. Have sacramentally confessed their sins;
- 2\*. Receive the Holy Eucharist (it is certainly better to receive it while participating in Holy Mass, but for the indulgence only Holy Communion is required);
3. Pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff (At least one Our Father and one Hail Mary) while at the basilica.

*\*Within several days of participating in the celebration*  
(USCCB, Manual Of Indulgences; N18,N19, N20)
