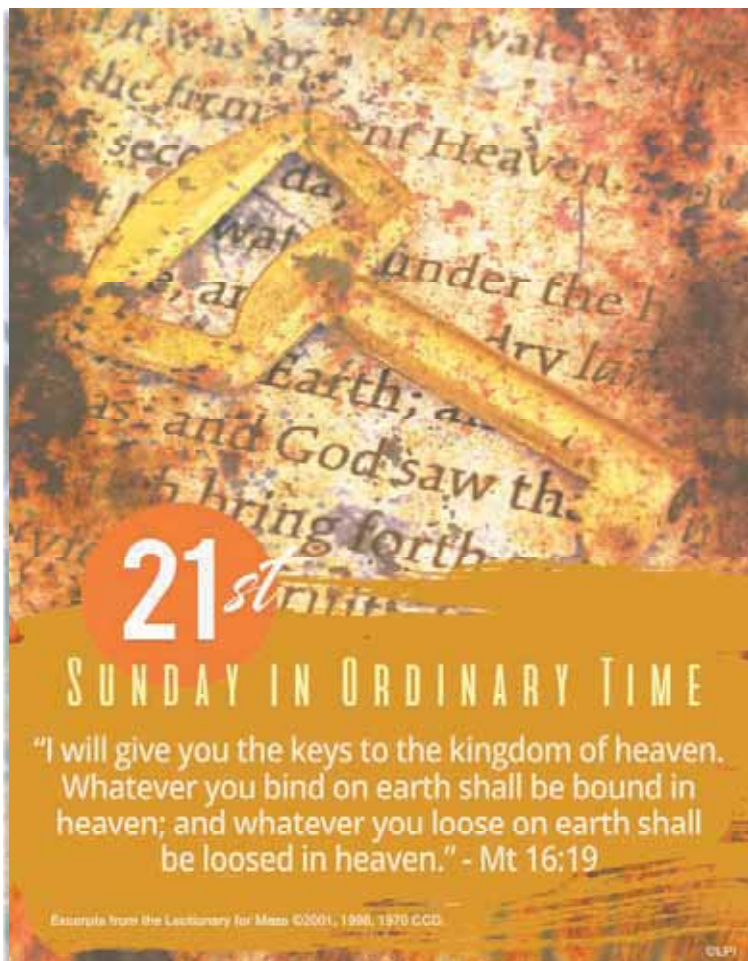

From the Deacon's Desk

Today we celebrate the twenty first Sunday in Ordinary time. This weekend is the last weekend of the month of August. Time flies when you are having fun! In the first reading from the prophet Isaiah the word "key" is used. Keys are used as a source of power, authority or responsibility. Keys are used to keep people in or out! The prophet states that "I will place the key of the House of David on Eliakim's shoulder; when he opens, no one shall shut when he shuts, no one shall open."

In the Gospel of Matthew for this weekend Peter, our first Pope, is given the authority and the responsibility of the Universal Church when he is told, "You are Peter and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven."

I remember fourteen and half months ago when I was appointed Parish Life Coordinator of the Basilica, and received a set of keys. These keys opened the hall, the church, the cabinets where we keep supplies and the key to open the church office and my office. Even though I am not the only person that has keys the keys do represent the authority and the responsibility given to me. I was informed by our Bishop that my appointment would be a temporary appointment. "We will see how you will perform and we'll see by Christmas or until a permanent Pastor is appointed." However, Christmas came and no change was made. I figured I was doing something right. Never in my wildest dreams did I ever think that I would be in the position I have been for the past fourteen months! It has been an honor and a privilege to have been part of the Basilica of San Albino family.

As I reflect back on my experience I am so thankful that I was given this opportunity. I hope and pray that I have served you all well. As I transition to my new assignment at Holy Cross Church; I encourage all of you to continue to work with your new Pastor, Fr. Chris Williams. He will need a lot of support in administering the Basilica. The church cannot function without so many of you involved and committed to so many needed ministries. I will hand my keys to Fr. Chris, and continue to pray for you all, and for Father Chris.

I thank all of you for your help, support and acceptance! I say to all, "Hasta la Vista!" until we meet again. I will be taking a month and a half off in order to spend time with my wife traveling and getting energized for our next call to ministry. May the good Lord continue to bless you and your family! Sacrament of Baptism

Worshiping with us at Mass is a time to spiritually prepare both you and your family for the Sacrament of Baptism.

Parents who are registered in the parish desiring and planning baptism for their child are to come by the office to register for baptism classes. Pre-baptism classes are required for both parents and Godparents. Godparents must have received the sacrament of Confirmation and, if married, married in the Roman Catholic Church and be receiving Holy Communion regularly. Only one Godparent is necessary. If two (2), then male and female are required. Please come by the office to register for baptism classes. Two consecutive classes are required. Classes are offered in English only. **The next classes are scheduled for Tuesday, Oct. 24th and Monday Oct. 30th, 2017. Please call the office to register.**

Active Parishioner Status

We receive many requests from parishioners to qualify for weddings here, or to be godparents or sponsors for the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, and to rightfully enjoy the number of services offered at the Basilica of San Albino. Part of that request is to be able to verify that a person is an "active member" of the Basilica. Because of the nature of our congregation, having so many visitors, it is difficult to know everyone.

An "active member" of the parish is one who:

- ◆ Is properly registered and on the parish census
- ◆ Faithfully attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days
- ◆ Participates in parish activities when possible
- ◆ Uses the parish envelope system

While assessments of an inquirer's status will be made individually, the above are the main factors that will be considered in making that determination.
