SAINT CHRISTOPHER

(Dates unknown)

Patron Saint of Travelers and Motorists

Feast day - July 25

Christopher was a giant Canaanite with a fearsome face. He took it into his head to go and serve “the greatest king there was”. Eventually he realized that no one is greater than Christ, so he searched for him. A hermit instructed him in the Christian faith. The hermit suggested that because of his size and strength Christopher could serve Christ by assisting people to cross a dangerous river, where they were perishing in the attempt.

One day a little child asked him to take him across the river. During the crossing, the river became swollen and the child seemed as heavy as lead, so that Christopher could scarcely carry him and found himself in great difficulty. When they reached the other side, Christopher mentioned to the child that the whole world could not have been as heavy as the child was. The child replied that he had not carried the entire world but Him who made it. “I am Christ your King, whom you are serving by this work.” The child then vanished.

Soon Christopher visited the city of Lycia to comfort the Christians who were being martyred there. Brought before the local king he refused to sacrifice to the pagan gods. The king tried to win him by riches and by sending two beautiful women to tempt him, but Christopher converted the women to Christianity. The king ordered him to be killed and Christopher was beheaded.
