**SAINT RITA OF CASCIA  
(1386-1456)**

**Patron Saint of Impossible causes and Difficult  
Marriages  
Feast day - May 22**

Rita of Cascia's holiness was reflected in each phase of her life. She was born at Rocca Porena in the Diocese of Spoleto in 1386.

Rita was the daughter of older parents who were distinguished for their charity which earned them the surname of Peacemakers of Jesus Christ. Rita's great desire was to become a nun, but in obedience to the will of her parents, she married a cruel and ill-tempered man at the age of twelve. She was a model wife and mother for eighteen years. When her husband was murdered she tried in vain to dissuade her twin sons from attempting to take revenge; she appealed to Heaven to prevent them from committing such a grave sin, and they were taken away by death, reconciled to God. She tried to be admitted to the Augustinian convent at Cascia, but, being a widow, was refused. By continued entreaties, and by Divine intervention, she gained admission, received the habit of the order and in due time her profession. As a religious she was an example for all, excelled in mortifications, and was well known for the effectiveness of her prayers.

In 1637, Pope Urban VIII, permitted her Mass and Office. On account of the many miracles reported to have been wrought at her intercession she received in Spain the title of *La Santa de los impossibles*. She was solemnly canonized 24 May, 1900 by Pope Leo XIII.

*The Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary  
Thursday, May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018*

The faithful who devoutly visit the basilica and within it participate in any sacred rite or at least recite the Lord's Prayer and the profession of faith may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions.

A *plenary indulgence* can be gained only *once a day*. In order to obtain it, the faithful must, in addition to being in the state of grace, participate in the celebration (Vespers or visit the basilica), must have the interior disposition of *complete detachment from sin, even venial sin* and:

- 1\*. *Have sacramentally confessed* their sins;
- 2\*. *Receive the Holy Eucharist* (it is certainly better to receive it while participating in Holy Mass, but for the indulgence only Holy Communion is required);
- 3\*. *Pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff (At least one Our Father and one Hail Mary) while at the basilica.*

*\*Within several days of participating in the celebration*
