From the Deacon's Desk

This weekend we celebrate the twelfth Sunday in Ordinary time. The first reading is taken from the Prophet Jeremiah. He tells us that, the Lord is with him as well as he is always with all of us to him he is, "Like a mighty champion: my persecutors will stumble, they will not triumph." These are very comforting words for all of us especially when we wonder and question, where is God in our lives? Many times, we hear in scripture that we should not be afraid for God is always at our side and He will never abandon us!

In today's Gospel of Matthew Jesus is sending his disciples out into the world telling them, "Fear no one and do not be afraid, you are worth more than many sparrows." Again, we are told not to be afraid, however, this is easier said than done. Throughout our lives we do experience fear. In this Gospel, we as baptized Catholic have the duty and obligation to be witnesses to the Word of God. We are also called to be "potential" prophets. The prophets and the priests sometimes experience criticism and opposition just because they are doing their job. Does this stop them from spreading the Good News out of fear of being ridiculed? I don't think so! Perhaps at times we are afraid of how people will see us if we speak up the truth and tend to shy away from being in the limelight.

All of us have had experiences in our lives where fear was a factor in changing our mind about carrying out our plans or goals. Perhaps it was a trip that you had planned and it was a place you wanted to visit but with the present terrorism threat at the place you wish to travel to, you either postpone it or omit it from even being part of your destination plan. I for one have not visited the city of Juarez as much as I used to for fear of all the violence that was reported in all news media not long ago.

Two years ago, I was told I needed radiation to take care of a prostate cancer. After undergoing several exams and procedures that was the only choice of treatment that I was given to me. I remember the first day as I lay there in the cold treatment room that was locked with a very heavy lead door, to protect the technicians, I was concerned and afraid. This was the first of forty-four consecutive days that my body would be exposed to radiation. I wondered about the long-lasting effects of the radiation not only burning the tumor but what about the rest of the area being zapped. I was reassured by the doctors and technicians that this was a very effective and proven method. Many men had gone through the treatment and had survived to tell about it. As I lay there I remembered a prayer that now I use when being confronted with fear. I repeated the prayer many times, "Sacred Heart of Jesus in You I trust." After repeating this prayer many times, I felt a sense of peace and I was able to complete all forty-four treatments successfully.

It is only through Faith in Jesus that we can overcome our fears and doubts! He tells us very clearly "do not be afraid, I am with you always." And He is, but we need to accept that truth in our heart and decide to live in His presence by making a conscious effort minute after minute, hour after hour, day after day for the rest of our lives here on earth, HE IS PRESENT IN US! And that there is no reason to be afraid. Last week we celebrated Corpus Christy with a beautiful procession around the Plaza. I thought about all the blessings received by this beautiful town with this procession. He is so close that He walks with us, lives in us, and wants us to visit with Him as much as we remember to do so. Let us all pray that we learn to turn our minds and hearts towards Him every single day of our lives!



Sacrament of Baptism

Worshipping with us at Mass is a time to spiritually prepare both you and your family for the Sacrament of Baptism.

Parents who are registered in the parish desiring and planning baptism for their child are to come by the office to register for baptism classes. Pre-baptism classes are required for both parents and Godparents. Godparents must have received the sacrament of Confirmation and, if married, married in the Roman Catholic Church and be receiving Holy Communion regularly. Only one Godparent is necessary. If two (2), then male and female are required. Please come by the office to register for baptism classes. Two consecutive classes are required. Classes are offered in English only. **The next classes are scheduled for Tuesday, Oct. 24th and Monday Oct. 30th, 2017. Please call the office to register.**

THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Jesus came to heal the whole person, body and soul. In the Church's Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, through the ministry of the priest, it is Jesus who touches the sick to heal them from sin - and sometimes even from physical ailment. His cures were signs of the arrival of the Kingdom of God. The core message of his healing tells us of his plan to conquer sin and death by his dying and rising.

The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient.

When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be God's will, the person be physically healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age.

Each first Friday of the month, this Sacrament is offered during the 9:00 a.m. Mass at the Basilica of San Albino. If you are in need of the Anointing of the Sick, or know someone who is, you are invited to join us or bring those who would like to have the Anointing but cannot bring themselves, to Mass on Friday, July 7, 2017.
